<p><b><u>The Pentateuch</u></b>          Genesis          Exodus          Leviticus          Numbers          Deuteronomy</p>	<p>Records events such as creation, man's fall into sin, the flood, the Israelites leaving Egypt, crossing the Red Sea, and the giving of the 10 Commandments. The tabernacle and sacrifices are discussed. Key characters include Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Joseph and Moses.</p>
<p><b><u>Historical Books</u></b>          Joshua          Judges          Ruth          I &amp; II Samuel          I &amp; II Kings          I &amp; II Chronicles          Ezra          Nehemiah          Esther</p>	<p>Years of Israel's history when the Israelite's faith and obedience to God were tested. Begins with Israel entering the Promised Land (Canaan), to their downfall (their division - Judah/Israel, and being taken out of their land), and ending with their eventual return and the rebuilding of Jerusalem. Key characters include Joshua, Saul, David, Solomon, Elijah and Elisha.</p>
<p><b><u>Poetry</u></b>          Job          Psalms          Proverbs          Ecclesiastes          Song of Solomon          Lamentations</p>	<p>Literature written by individuals who were experiencing a wide variety of circumstances, ranging from extreme suffering to great blessing. True wisdom, the fear of God, and the meaning of life are highlighted.</p>
<p><b><u>Major Prophets</u></b>          Isaiah          Jeremiah          Ezekiel          Daniel</p>	<p>Prophecies about the coming Messiah and the future, as well as comfort when the Israelites were in captivity. Also includes strong warnings urging the people to return to obedience to God.</p>
<p><b><u>Minor Prophets</u></b>          Hosea      Nahum          Joel        Habakkuk          Amos        Zephaniah          Obadiah    Haggia          Jonah        Zechariah          Micah        Malachi</p>	<p>Warnings of God's judgment if the Israelites continued in their rebellion against Him. Tells of God's readiness to offer forgiveness and blessing if the people would turn back to Him. Prophecies about the coming Messiah are also included.</p>
