# God Is Merciful

### What Does This Mean?

- God shows mankind "<u>loving kindness</u>."
- Mercy is <u>compassion</u> and <u>goodness</u> freely given toward someone in need.
- Just as with grace, it is God's right to determine who will <u>receive</u> His mercy.

### > Where Do We See This in Scripture?

- "The Lord is gracious and merciful...and His <u>mercy</u> is over all that he has made" (Ps. 145:8-9).
- Paul described God as being "<u>rich</u> in mercy" (Eph.
  2:4) and James stated that He "is compassionate and merciful" (James 5:11).
- God shows mercy and compassions in accordance with His <u>will</u> (Rom. 9:14-16).
- <u>Forgiveness</u> of <u>sin</u> comes by the "tender mercy of our God" (Luke 1:77-78; note I Pet. 1:3).
- In the gift of salvation, God's mercy is displayed to even the <u>worst</u> of <u>sinners</u>. Paul stated, "Though formerly I was a blasphemer, persecutor, and insolent opponent...I received mercy" (I Tim. 1:13).

## What Does This Mean for Me?

- ⇒ Think about this verse phrase by phrase: "God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Rom. 5:8). How many acts of God's mercy does this verse reveal?
- ⇒ We should show mercy toward others: "Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful" (Luke 6:36). What <u>resources</u> and/or <u>abilities</u> has God given you which could be used in showing compassion to others (note Matt. 5:7)?
