# Christian Doctrine God (Part 14)

**Attributes: What Is He Like?** 

#### God Is True

#### What Does This Mean?

- God being "true" emphasizes the reality of His existence.
- God being "true" emphasizes that He is the source and standard for all truth.
- Everything God has said about <u>Himself</u> and the <u>world</u> is completely accurate and everything He has <u>promised</u> to do will come to pass.

## Where Do We See This in Scripture?

- God is described as "the <u>true</u> God" (Jer. 10:10) and "the <u>only true</u> God" (John 17:3; note I John 5:20).
- People turned from dead idols "to serve the <u>living</u> and <u>true</u> God" (I Thess. 1:9).
- Jesus, the perfect expression of truth, said, "I am the way, and the <u>truth</u>, and the life..." (John 14:6).
- Since He is truthful, it is impossible for God to <u>lie</u> or break a <u>promise</u> (Prov. 30:5; Titus 1:2).

### What Does This Mean for Me?

- ⇒ We must worship God in spirit and in <u>truth</u> (John 4:24). In our worship and praise to God, we must take utmost care that our words and actions reflect only that which is <u>true</u> about God.
- ⇒ It should be our desire to continually <u>grow</u> in our knowledge of truth (truth about God, the world, etc.). Growing in our knowledge shows that we appreciate and understand the importance of truth.
- ⇒ Those who claim to have a relationship with God should be characterized as being <u>honest</u> and <u>genuine</u> (Eph. 4:25). Our lives should accurately represent the God we serve.
