Christian Doctrine Mankind (Part 5) What Are Our Roles as Men and Women?

Men and Women Were Created Equal

As creations of God, we must recognize that whether we are a man or a woman, we were <u>equally</u> created in the image of God (Gen. 1:27; 5:1–2). Therefore, all people are equally <u>important</u> and <u>valuable</u> to God. It is wrong to say, as some cultures do, that men are more important than women, just as it would be wrong to say that women are more important than men. Scripture makes this clear in several aspects:

- Both have spiritual <u>gifts</u> and are equally <u>important</u> to the church (I Cor. 12:7, 12; I Pet. 4:10).
- Both <u>rely on</u> and <u>need</u> each other (I Cor. 11:11-12).
- Both are to give <u>honor</u> to the other (I Pet. 3:7; I Cor. 11:7).

Men and Women Have Different Roles to Fill

While it is true that men and women are completely equal, we must also recognize that each have their own <u>roles</u> to fill. From the beginning, man was created with the role of being the <u>leader</u>. For this reason, Adam was responsible for his family's <u>actions</u> (God went to *him* first after the fall -Gen. 3:9). Men have also been given the role of being the leaders within the <u>church</u> and submitting to Christ (I Tim. 3:1-13; I Tim. 2:11-14). Eve was created as a <u>helper</u> to Adam (Gen. 2:18) and has the role of <u>submitting</u> to the authority given to her husband (Eph. 5:22-24).

Different Roles Working in Perfect Harmony

The purpose of roles may most clearly be seen in God's design of the husband/wife relationship. The husband is to <u>love</u> his wife just as Christ loved the church. This means that he must be willing to <u>serve</u> his wife and <u>sacrifice</u> for her well-being (Eph. 5:25). In response, the wife <u>submits</u> to him and <u>respects</u> him for his God-given role as the leader (Eph. 5:22-24). Only when this is done, can the couple live in perfect <u>harmony</u> as God intended. As we trust God and obediently fulfill each of our roles, we enjoy the blessing and harmony He desires for us.
