

Ephesians 3:14-21

The Love and Power of God

- > What is Paul's prayer request in [verse 16](#)? That we would be strengthened with God's might through our inner being.
- > [Verse 17](#) says we should be "rooted and grounded in love." What does that mean and why is it important? Love should be a foundational principle of our lives. And when it is, then the way we live will be characterized by love.
- > Try to rephrase in your own words how Christ's love is described in [verses 18-19a](#): Christ's love is so great that it is beyond measure. His love for us is beyond our comprehension.
- > What does [verse 20](#) say about God's power? God continually shows His power by doing above what we ask or even imagine. He uses that same power to work in our lives.

Application

We see that Paul is overwhelmed by two concepts: Christ's love and God's power! Our walk with the Lord will always be strengthened when we dwelling on these two topics.

- > How can the love of Christ impact the way we think and act? Realize we are objects of His great love. Respond to His love w/attitudes that please Him and work on showing His love to others.
- > How can God's power impact the way we think and act? We must recognize that we serve a God who is unlimited in power. Place our confidence in Him and let Him work in us and through us.

Think of ways believers can respond to Christ's love and ways we can show confidence in the power of God. Next, ask yourself, what specifically does God want you to do as a response to His love and a show of your confidence in His power? Commit to doing that this week! Then be willing to share with someone the reason behind your actions!
