## Teen Topics A Biblical Worldview (Conclusion)

Through this study we have searched the Scriptures to answer eight main questions that affect how we approach life. In so doing, we have gained a better understanding of how to view our world from a biblical perspective.

## The Importance of a Biblical Worldview

In our "Intro" lesson, we stated a worldview is "everything we believe and understand about life and the world around us which impacts how we act and think." The impact from a biblical worldview can be seen in many ways:

- A correct view of God allows us to understand Him for who He is and to find the <u>foundation</u> for our life in Him and in His Word.
- A correct view of ourselves and the people around us helps us to realize that we are all here by God's <u>design</u> and that we have specific <u>responsibilities</u> to meet as we live among each other.
- A correct view of what we see happening in the world around us gives us a <u>confidence</u> in the almighty hand of God in world affairs and a <u>desire</u> to allow Him to use our lives for His purposes.

## Approaching Life God's Way

God has not created us to search out and discover the meaning of life on our own. He has already given us the answers to the deep questions of life. It is within this biblical worldview that we can not only understand, but also live out the <u>reason</u> for our <u>existence</u>. Seeing what God has to say about life allows us to approach each new day with a determined <u>focus</u>. No matter what situations or challenges a day may bring, our focus can be one in which we are looking at life God's way, and praising Him for the great <u>opportunity</u> and joy that comes with living the life He has given to us (John 15:11; 17:13)!
